Food Vendor Requirements

Dear Vendor,

Thank you for your application to attend Fairplay Burro Days. With your application acceptance we need to let you know of some additional requirements you need in order to attend Burro Days.

The Park County Environmental Health Department requires that **ALL** food vendors (including those selling prepackaged foods) contact and complete an application for a Park County food vendor's license. This license is in addition to any licensing that you have already received from the State of Colorado and any City, Town or County municipalities in other parts of Colorado or other states.

This is extremely important because Park County Environmental Health will not allow you to setup at any event in Park County without this license issued by them.

Because of this, the Town requires you to contact Park County Environmental Health **prior to June 1st, 2017** and be in possession of your license **no later than 45 days** prior to our event. With this time frame it will allow your application to be processed in plenty of time so that any issues can be addressed before the Environmental Health deadline. The Town will not refund booth fees after July 1st, 2017 so if you do not get the required licenses by the dates above and cannot attend because of that we **will not** be able to refund your booth fee. We apologize for this strong policy but please understand if you do not get your license by the dates above we do not have enough time to find a replacement vendor and have them licensed in time for our event.
